	FIRE	LOCKDOWN	EARTHQUAKE	SHELTER IN PLACE
<b>SCHOOL PROCEDURE</b>	<p>Students will exit the building and move to the predetermined spot in the rear of the school (north side) under teacher direction. In case of inclement weather, the school has arrangements to use the church building just west of the school.</p>	<p>Students will remain in locked classrooms under teacher direction until the building is cleared by police.</p> <p>If the threat (<i>human or chemical</i>) is outside of the building, the exterior of the building will be secured to keep the threat outside. Students in portables will remain in their locked classroom.</p>	<p>Students will “duck, cover, and hold” under their desks during the earthquake. As soon as it is safe to move, students will follow FIRE procedures.</p>	<p><u>Blizzard</u>: Decisions to keep children at school will be based on road conditions. If students are kept at school, they will use emergency supplies and resources stored at the school, as needed.</p> <p><u>Chemical Spill</u>: Decisions to keep children at school will be based on safety. If students are kept at school, they will use emergency supplies and resources stored at the school, as needed.</p>
