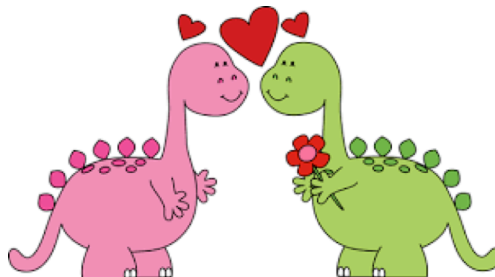
# Show Love with a Growth Mindset

We can show love with a growth mindset. We can show love by helping others while having fun and sometimes even helping yourself.

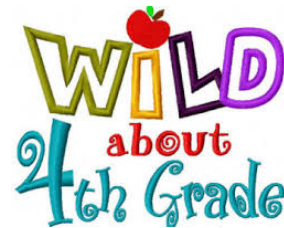


# *What Have We Been Up To?*
