

## Landtrust Summary Final Report 2019-2020

Butterfield Canyon received \$110,425.00 from the School Landtrust during the 2019-2020 school year. These funds were used to support students in reaching the following goals.

### Schoolwide Goals:

1. Reading - We increased the percent of students showing one year's growth in reading from 58% to 78%.
2. Math - We increased the number of students mastering grade level math concepts from 39% to 61%

This is how funds were used to support student learning.

- Teachers were provided time to meet in professional learning communities each week to analyze data and discuss student needs.
- Our master schedule was set up to provide teachers with a 30-minute block of time for math interventions and enrichment, called WIN (Whatever I Need) time. WIN time occurred 4 times a week during the school year.
- Assistants were hired to provide help and support to the teachers during the schedule WIN time to ensure students were receiving appropriate interventions and enrichment.
- Paraprofessionals and substitutes were hired to provide support for provisional and veteran teachers to be able to observe other teachers and participate in peer coaching.
- Teachers received ongoing professional development through monthly faculty meetings.
- Teachers were able to attend conferences to learn more about strategies to improve student learning.
- Substitute teachers and/or paraprofessionals covered classes so teachers could meet and/or attend conferences.
