Students may be asked by faculty or staff to remove hats if they becomes distracting. **Why no hoodies, blocks** identity, face not completely visible, and disrupts learning environment. Teacher input supports this.

Clothing : Mid drift should not be visible with **any movement**.

- a. Must cover the top of the armpit to approximately mid-thigh with no viewable undergarments (Waistbands and bra straps excluded)
- b. Must be from the top of one armpit to another and connected from the front to back over the shoulder, have fabric in front (covering abdomen), on the sides (under the arms) and have a closed back (covering the upper and lower back)
- c. Provide coverage of the buttocks, genitals, and chest with a fabric that is not see-through.
- d. If spaghetti straps become a problem this will be **reassessed**.
