



IMMUNIZATION EXEMPTIONS

For children, whose legal guardian claims an exemption to immunization for medical, religious, or personal reasons, the legal guardian must complete an online immunization education module at <u>immunize.utah.gov</u> or an in-person consultation at a local health department. A copy of the form must be presented to the school or childcare official, as well as a statement signed by a licensed healthcare provider for the medical exemption. - 1. Access the Education module from immunize.utah.gov.
- 2. Hover over "School & Early Childhood Program Requirements".



- 3. Click on "Immunization Education Module (Exemptions)".
- 4. Scroll down and click the green icon to access the Online Immunization Education Module.






6. Enter user information. The user is the legally responsible adult.
